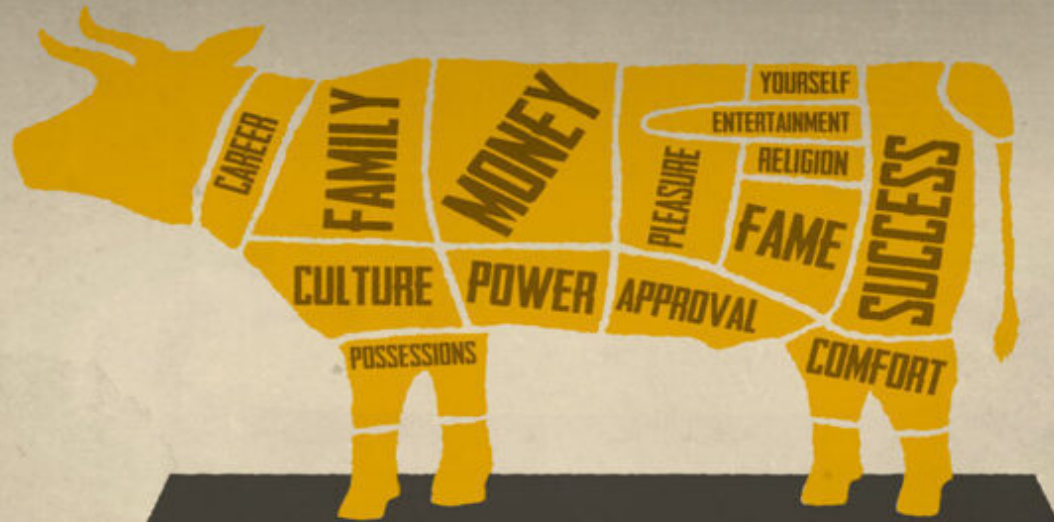

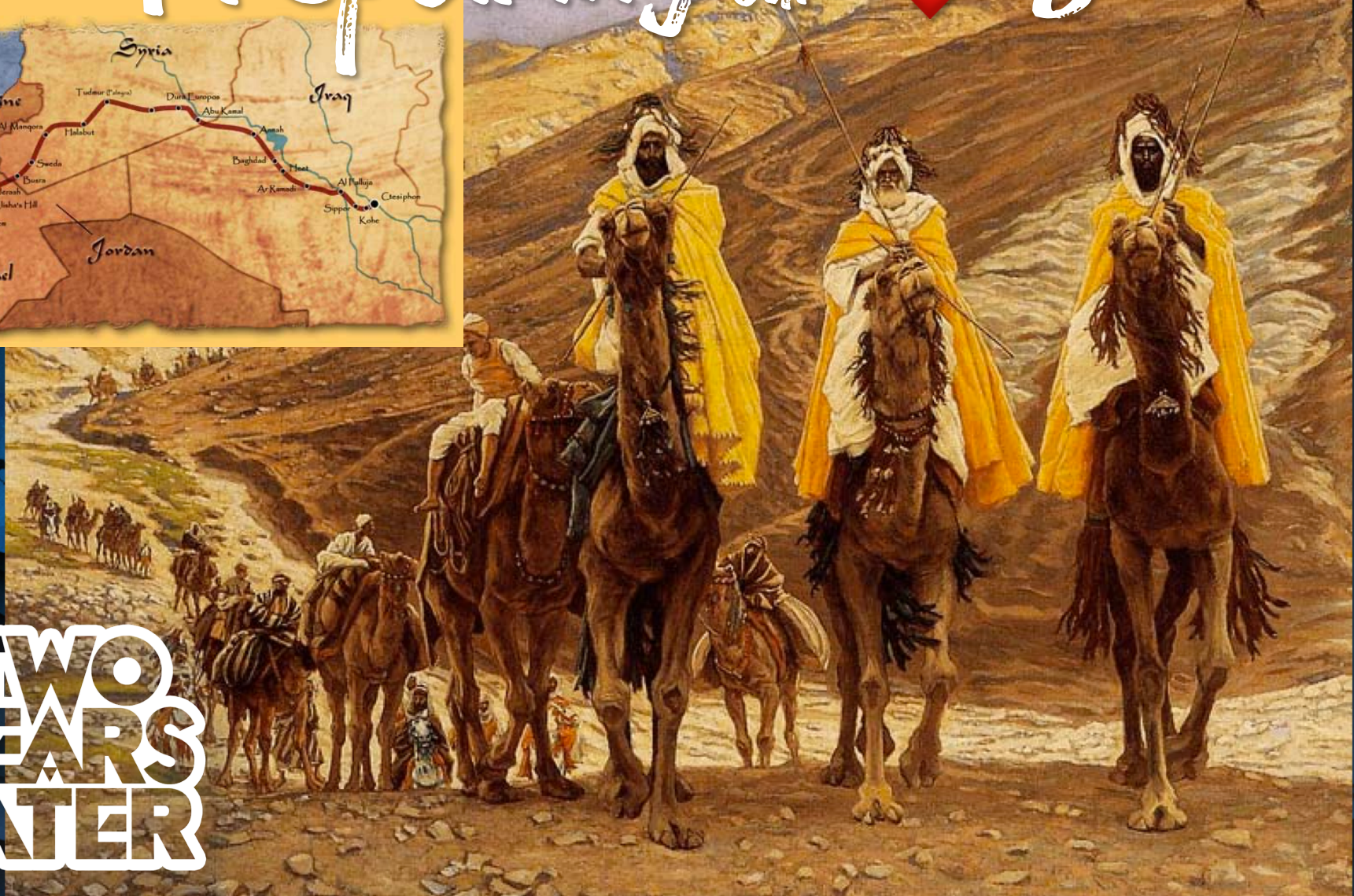
What to Expect

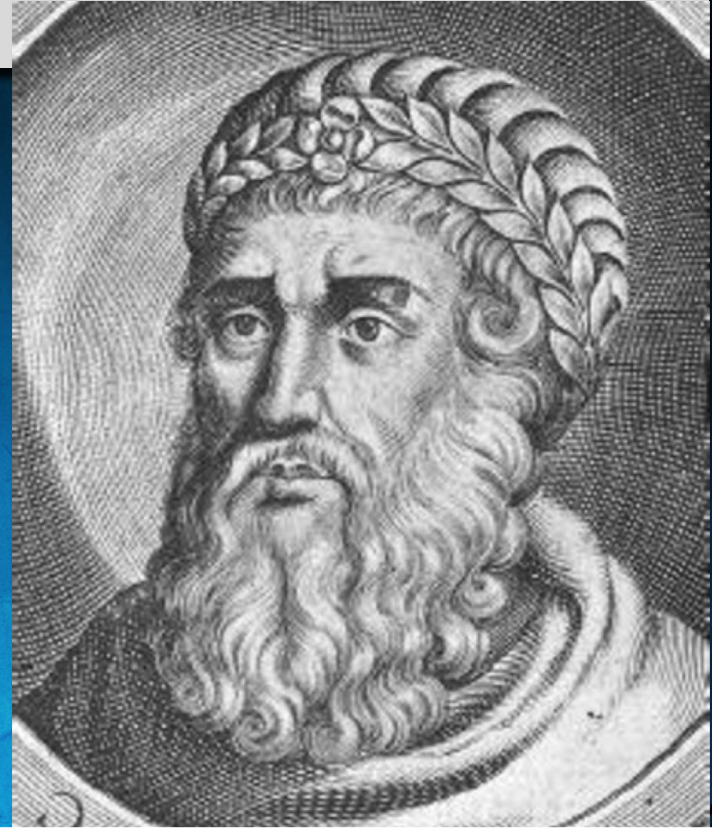

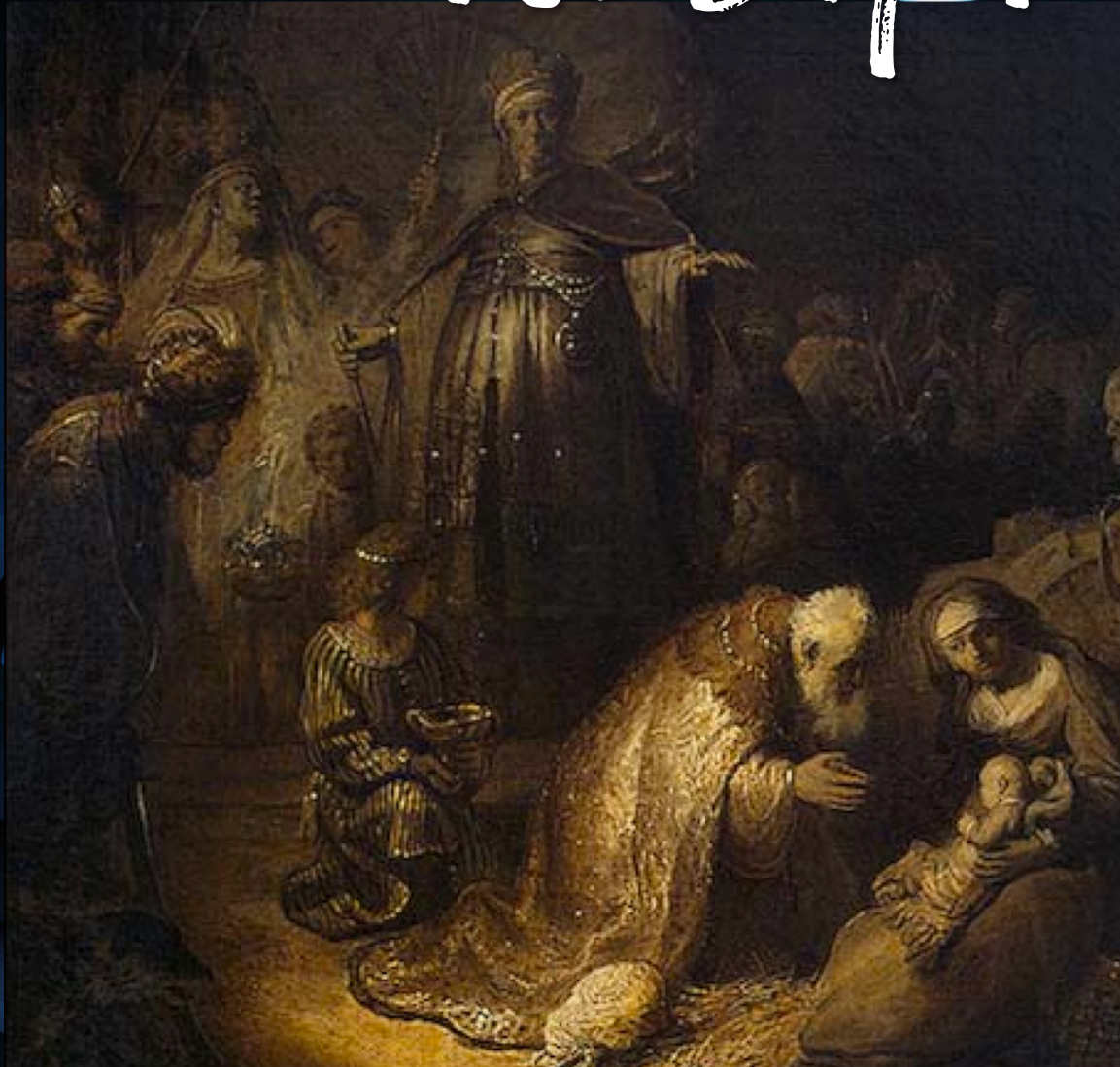
Jealous of Jesus

Worship FULLY



Worship isn't something that happens passively or automatically. **TRUE WORSHIP** demands **attention** and **effort** and **sacrifice**.

Think about the magi:

- They spent years watching and waiting for the Messiah.
- They spent months preparing and months travelling.
- They endured danger and threats and uncomfortable situations.
- All to worship Jesus...

“On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him.”

What is Worship?

- **Worship** is more than showing up.
(but at least they do)
- **Worship** is not about receiving.
(many come to Jesus to receive, but that's not the posture of worship)
- **Worship** is about giving...
- **Worship** is giving Jesus what He wants.
(they opened their treasures - they gave the things that they treasured)
