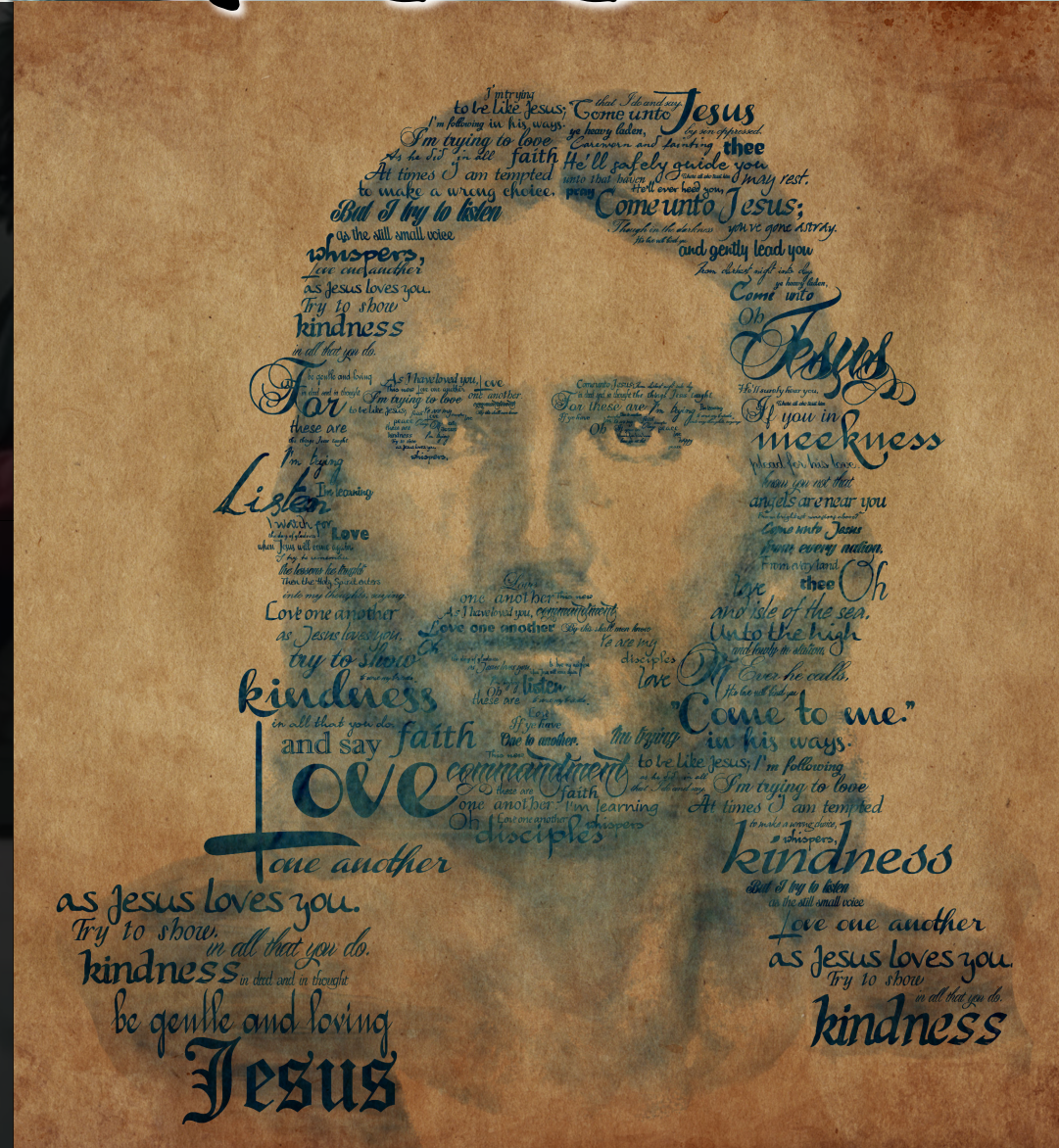

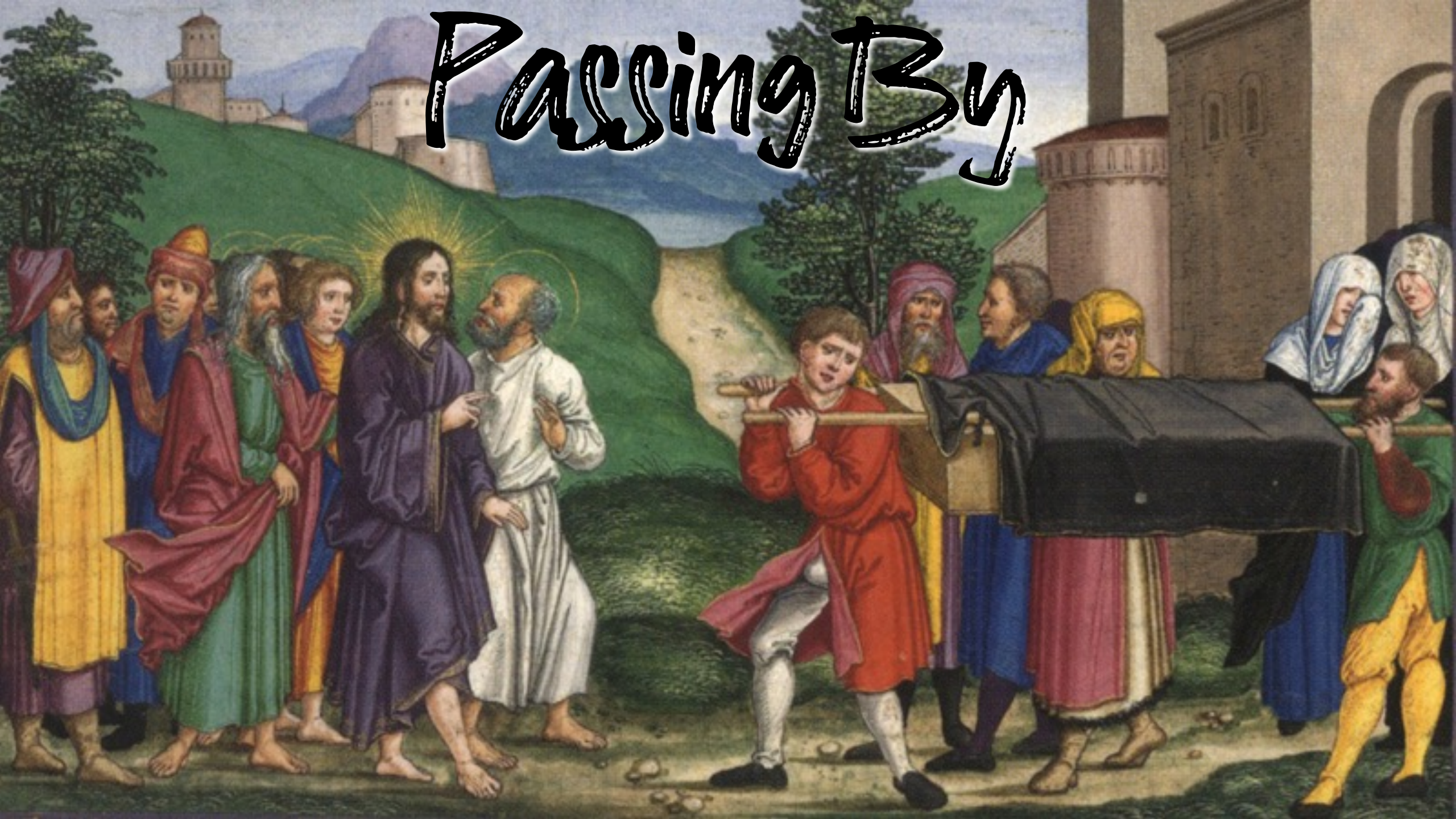


Blinders On...
