“Show them great respect and wholehearted love because of their work. And live peacefully with each other...”

Show Respect: Respect is given to someone for who they are and what they can do. It hinges around externals: Around character, gifts, skills, and abilities. Those we respect we treat with gratitude, humility, and awe.

Whole Hearted Love: Love results from the bond we have with others. When we love people with whole-hearted affection, we think of ways we can express our love for them outwardly, often at great cost to ourselves.

Remove Impediments: Make the lives of those who work hard among you better. Work hard for their sake, take loads off of them. Take away areas of frustration from them by doing what you can in treating each other like Jesus would.
